

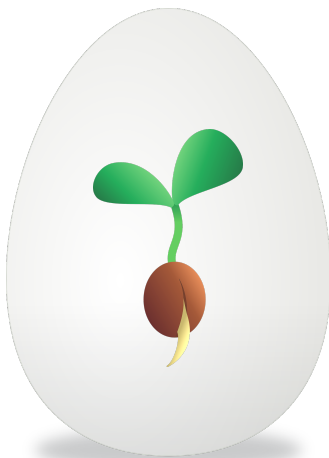
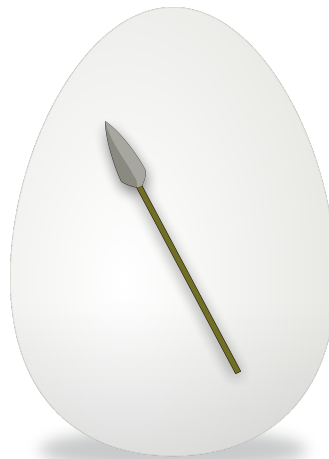


Pictures of the Passion Easter Eggs
