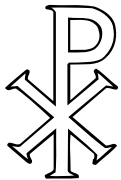

Take a look at all of the special decorations that adorn the Christmas tree at church. You may have some that are called *Chrismons*. Each hand-made ornament is based on a symbol taken from the Bible. For example, the symbol to the left is called a “chi-rho” (pronounced “k-eye-row”) It’s made from the first two letters of the Greek word *Christ*: Χριστός
